

This work is devoted to Viśvarūpa's *Bhāṣāvṛttivivaraṇapañjikā*, a late Sanskrit grammatical treatise, and consists of two volumes. The first contains the critical edition of the first *adhyāya* of the *Bhāṣāvṛttivivaraṇapañjikā*. The second begins with the presentation of the history of the Bengali tradition of Pāṇini's grammar, to which tradition Viśvarūpa was indebted, and proceeds with a thorough analysis of the *Bhāṣāvṛttivivaraṇapañjikā*. The methods applied in the latter part unite those of indology with linguistics, with the particular emphasis being put on the achievements of discourse analysis.
